

**WEST KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

BEER AND WINE COMPETITION**

West, Texas

Section I.....General Rules

1. A person may enter one or multiple entries in both the beer or wine divisions. Within a class, a person may enter up to three times with different batches. Beer and Wine batches that are eligible to enter can be made in 2010 or earlier years. Anyone may submit entries in the challenge except the judges and commercial wine producers.
2. For each beer or wine entry, there is a registration fee of \$6.00 to cover costs of plaques.
3. A Beer entry **MUST** consist of 7 bottles of at least 12 oz each for a total of 84 oz.. A Wine entry **MUST** consist of two bottles of no more than 1 liter in size or equivalent US measure (1 quart) and no less than 750 ml (1 ½ pints). In the case of Beer, one bottle will be judged and the other 6 bottles will be placed for sale in an **AUCTION** with the proceeds going to the Church. In the Wine category, one bottle will be judged and the 2nd bottle will be placed for sale in an **AUCTION** with the proceeds going to the Church.
4. **No labels on bottles will be allowed.** All judging will be a blind test. A tag will be provided for each entry on the date of the judging. Information on the tag will be completed by the entrant and a designated official.
5. All entries must be checked in between 10:00 and 11:30 a.m. on the day of judging at a designated spot in the K.C. Hall. Judging will begin promptly at noon.
6. If a beer or wine has been misclassified, the judges have the prerogative to place it in the proper classification.
7. Competent and non-partial judges will be provided.
8. First and second places will be awarded in each Division.
